Visits to Sheltered and Care Housing

Due to the success of visits by older people from BME communities and staff to sheltered and care housing further visits were organised for Nari Kalyan Sangho (NKS), Minority Ethnic Carers of Older People Project (MECOPP) and Multicultural Elderly Care Centre (MECC). The visitors were able to ask direct questions from staff and see the benefits of support in Sheltered Housing for themselves. The organisations visited sheltered housing developments in Edinburgh, Callander, Troon, Alexandria and Helensburgh and the feedback has been very positive.
