Housing for Older People

These three national Housing Associations provide housing with support and care services for older people in the community.

Amenity and Sheltered Housing are specially designed for older people. Sheltered Housing has a scheme manager with a 24 hours emergency alarm service operating whenever the manager is unavailable.

Very Sheltered and Care Housing generally include all of the above with the addition of 24 hours staff presence and meal provision. In Very Sheltered housing, personal care needs are normally met by Social Work. In Care housing, personal care needs are met and all meals are provided.

Most developments have communal laundries, guestrooms and communal lounges.

If you are 60 years and over, you can apply for housing.

The Associations will help with-

- Advise on housing options most suitable to your needs
- Help with applying and completing housing application forms
- Assistance in your own language
- Home visits or meeting at a place more suitable to you
- Holding open information sessions for general advice and assistance
